The We All Count Campaign is led by grassroots organizations in the Southern Movement Alliance to increase voter education and registration in under-represented communities, train new organizers, and create a Southern People's Plan to activate our communities beyond the elections in November.

Democracy in the US has failed everyday people.

In 2012, the number of US residents legally excluded from participating in the national election will be the highest since the Voting Rights Act was passed in 1965. Millions of people are being excluded from the elections, and Project South is committed to organize with people who are discouraged, intimidated, and legislated out of the process.

We have to show a strong force against right wing attempts to control our lives.

In this election, we have a responsibility to show up at the polls to hold a line against right wing efforts to use local policies to restrict people's rights, criminalize whole communities, and deepen the economic crisis. We know voting is not enough, and we are committed to developing a people's plan regardless of who is elected in November.

As Southerners, we are part of a legacy that fights for democracy for all people.

In 2012, energy and resources driven into the national elections threaten to weaken social movement efforts, and the South will be left for "red" by the electoral machine. The Southern Movement Assembly represents a powerful space to re-imagine what a people's democracy looks like and take ACTION.

The We All Count campaign will train and support 50 organizers to engage 1000s of people to be part of a broad social movement for racial, economic, and social justice.
